Senator Gordon Trimble

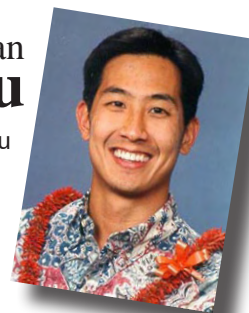
Senator Gordon Trimble has served the State of Hawaii since 1974. As Administrator of Foreign-Trade Zone #9, he supported Hawaii's small businesses and built on his economics background. Trimble's life has been dedicated to service; he was an Eagle Scout and Peace Corps volunteer. Gordon Trimble has represented the residents of Senate District 12 since 2002.

Senator Trimble currently sits on the Consumer Protection and Affordable Housing, Transportation and International Affairs, Energy and Environment, and Tourism and Government Operations committees.

Gordon and Sonia Trimble were married in the summer of 1969. They have one son, Robert, who is a graduate of St. Louis High School and the University of Puget Sound.

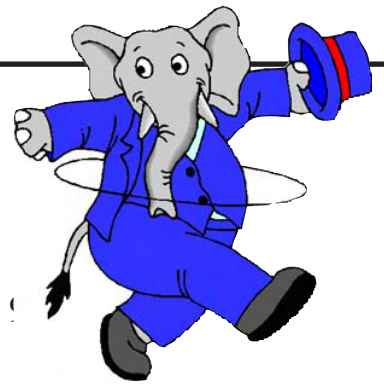

In addition to the volunteer support our members also bought one full table and many additional seats at the dinner.

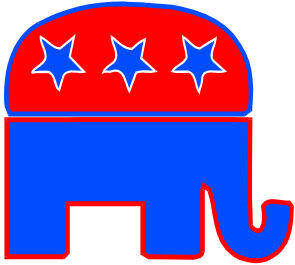
