Charles is married to Stacey Kawasaki Djou and together they have three children.


Councilman Djou, our only Republican council member on Oahu, will discuss the *controversial hot topics of rail and recycling.*

able to join us for our March luncheon.



In addition to the volunteer support our members also bought one full table and many additional seats at the dinner.


