Peter Carlisle Prosecuting Attorney

In November 1996, Peter Carlisle was elected Prosecuting Attorney of the City and County of Honolulu. In September of 2000, Carlisle was elected to his second term without opposition. It was the first time in the history of the State of Hawaii that the Honolulu prosecutor ran unopposed. In 2004, Carlisle was elected to an unprecedented third term as Honolulu's Prosecuting Attorney.

As Prosecuting Attorney, Carlisle has personally handled the trials of several significant cases. Carlisle was the lead trial attorney in State v. Byran Uyesugi. Uyesugi, entered the Xerox warehouse and methodically shot and killed seven of his coworkers. It was the deadliest mass murder in the history of the State of Hawaii. Uyesugi was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole.

Carlisle also prosecuted off-duty Honolulu Police Officer Clyde Arakawa for manslaughter. Arakawa drank at least 12 beers and a shot of hard liquor. On his way home Arakawa ran a red light and crushed into a car driven by 19-year-old Dana Ambrose, killing her instantly. Arakawa was sentenced to 20 years in prison.

Peter is a former Adjunct Professor at the University Of Hawaii William S. Richardson School Of Law. He has been an invited speaker both nationally and internationally on a variety of subjects including terrorism and the local prosecutor, drunken driving homicides, crimes against tourists and crystal methamphetamine.

Carlisle is the recipient of numerous awards and other recognition including the MADD Criminal Justice Award, induction into the Hawaii Joint Police Association Hall of Fame, the Golden Gavel Award for outstanding service to Hawaii's Judiciary and the Lifetime Achievement Award presented by the Law Enforcement Security Association.

A 1977 Graduate of UCLA Law School, Carlisle is married with two children.

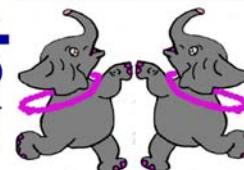

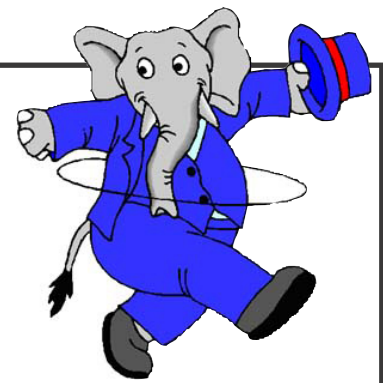
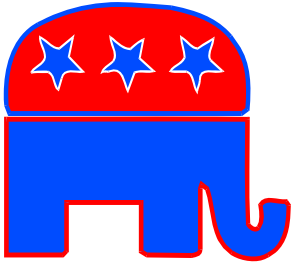
Upcoming Events
