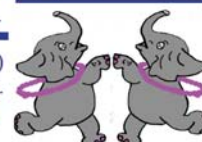

If our candidates are in place by early 2010 they can help formulate a platform that will help them run as a team and win.

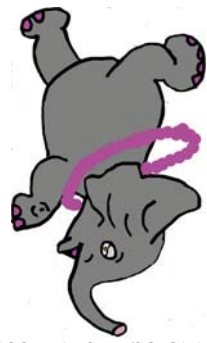
Let's do our part, as a club, and help find them be ready to stand behind those candidates with monetary and volunteer support.

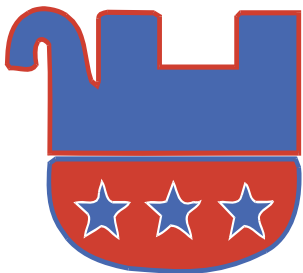
