Representative Pine has a strong work ethic and a passionate desire to succeed. She graduated from the University of California, Berkeley with a Bachelors Degree in English and is an accomplished journalist. She has won numerous awards for her writing, and was the youngest to be appointed as Director of Minority Research in the State House of Representatives.

Her work in policy has received extensive coverage in local television, radio, and print media as well as the Governor and the Lt. Governor's offices. Seven years of experience at the state capitol enabled her to gracefully assume the office of Representative, 43rd District, when she was elected to the State House of Representatives in 2004, defeating an incumbent with 60% of the vote. District 43 includes West Loch Fairways, West Loch Village, Ewa by Gentry, Puuloa, Ocean Pointe, Ewa Beach and Iroquois Point. She is the first Republican to be elected to this seat since statehood.

Public service is not the only part of Kimberly's life that she works hard at. She is also an accomplished athlete including paddling, swimming, soccer and track. In Ewa Beach, Kimberly is a member of the Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church where she is a lector and member of the Filipino Catholic Club. She is also a member of the Ewa Beach Lions Club, is an AYSO Soccer Coach and former Chairperson of the Ewa Beach Weed and Seed Neighborhood Restoration Project.
