Luncheon Speaker is Rep. Corinne Ching

Born and raised in Hawaii, Corinne serves as the State Representative for the 27th District which includes Liliha. She is a member of the following committees; Education, Higher Education, Energy & Environmental Protection, Housing, and Water, Land, & Ocean Resources. Prior to her election she served on the Liliha Neighborhood Board and taught English as a second language at Ma'ema'e School. She strongly supports Historic Preservation and

believes in the significance of design and the relationship of the built environment to a healthy community.

Along those lines she founded the Hawaii Heritage Caucus in 2002 to identify, protect, and preserve the state's cultural resources and to foster widespread appreciation of and respect for Hawaii's cultural heritage. Several years earlier she began the Historic Preservation Awareness Day at the State Capital an annual event to help educate the people of Hawai'i on importance of preserving one's culture, history, and heritage.

In her community she has created the "I Love Liliha" Town Festival, an event which brings together the diverse sectors of the Liliha community once a year in August, the "Liliha-Nuuanu Candlelight Tour", the "Historic Fun/Run Walk", which raises funds for historic sites, and Liliha Gingerbread Festival. She has created publications which include the I Love Liliha Booklet and "Our Liliha Honolulu's Hidden Gem" a Pele-Award winning Calendar.

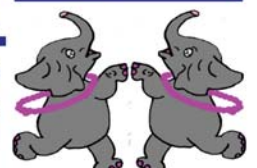

Nancy Gallagher won the 50/50 drawing. \$50 went to Nancy and \$50 went to the OLRW PAC.

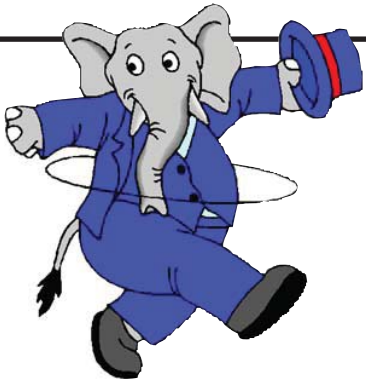


Painted Rainbows note cards are available as a fundraising item again. There are two designs available - Tropical Flowers or Flags. Both come with Crystal Clear envelopes.

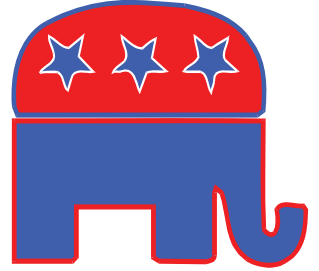
Friday, November 6, 2009 **Dancing with the Republican Stars**
