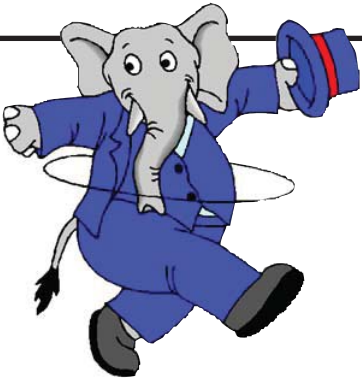

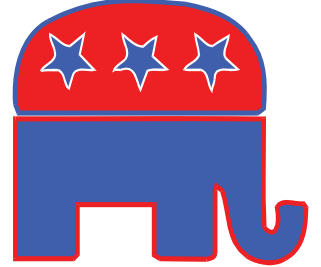
There is no charge to attend the Summit.
