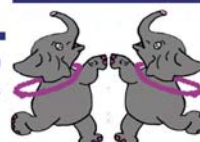

Our speaker was Officer Eddie Croom who substituted for Kim Buffett from Crime Stoppers. Officer Croom is a 20-year HPD officer assigned to the Speakers Bureau, Community Affairs Section. He is the curator of HPD's Law Enforcement Museum, their historian and web master. He retired from the US Air Force after 22 years.

Officer Croom was an exceptional speaker and thoroughly enjoyable. He spoke on personal safety, I.D. theft and answered numerous questions. Some of his advice included being safe as pedestrians and mindful of your surroundings. Officer Croom recommended using smaller handbags and keeping it tucked close to your body. He cautioned on

parking your car in a safe place, locking it and always observing your car upon return. Always check your interior before entering your car.



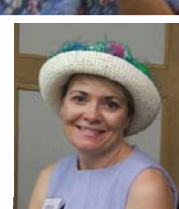
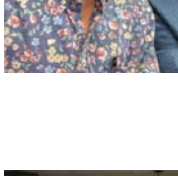

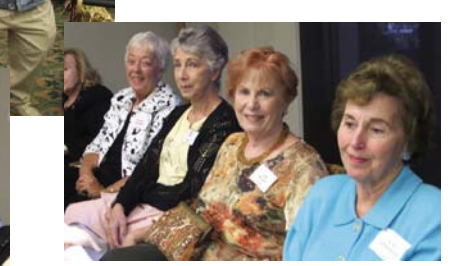

Lynn Meiers won the 50/50 drawing. \$43 went to and \$42 went to the OLRW PAC.



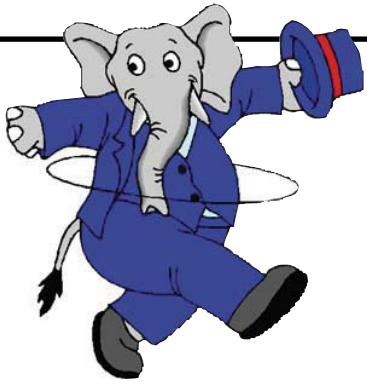
Thanks to everybody who participated in our Easter Bonnet contest! Everyone looked so festive, our judges had a hard time deciding.

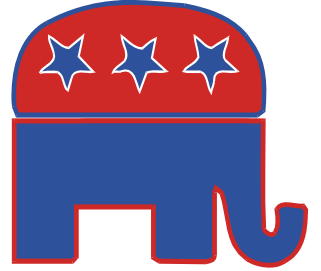
