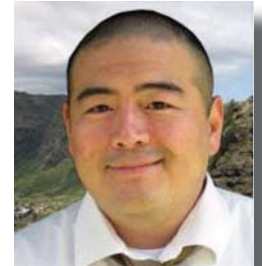

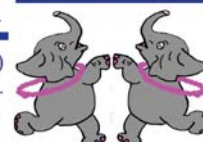

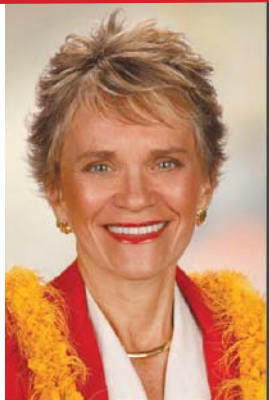
Minutes from the April meeting were circulated for review. There were no corrections or additions. The minutes will stand as presented.

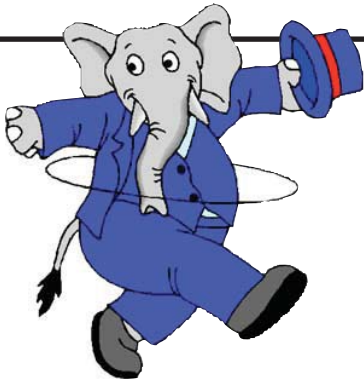

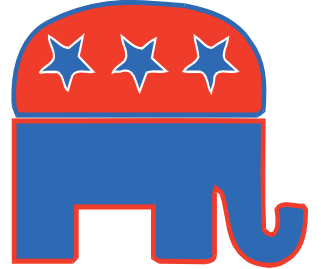
