## July Speaker

Republican Mayoral Candidate  
**Panos Prevedouros**



Panos Prevedouros is a professor of civil engineering at the University of Hawaii. He is considered one of the preeminent authorities in his field. Over the past ten years, he has been invited to give his professional opinion in ten countries and 33 large cities worldwide, including Beijing, Chicago, Houston, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, London, Munich, New York, Paris, San Diego, Tokyo, Venice, Vienna and Washington, D.C.

In 2008 in his run for Mayor of Honolulu he received almost 20% of the vote in the primary as a virtual unknown.

Panos understands that infrastructure has a profound effect on our biggest economic engine, tourism, and the people who live here. He is committed to repairing and maintaining Oahu's aging infrastructure, increasing efficiency in all city departments and finding real solutions for the problems faced by the residents of our city. People want tax and traffic relief and fiscally responsible projects that provide local jobs. Panos pledges to practice strict fiscal discipline and respect the taxpayers' every dollar.

If elected Panos will work to repeal the rail tax. After all, we won't need the tax if he finds alternative, smart solutions to our transportation problems and scraps the overpriced train that is a blight on our beautiful environment.

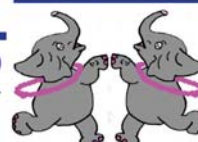

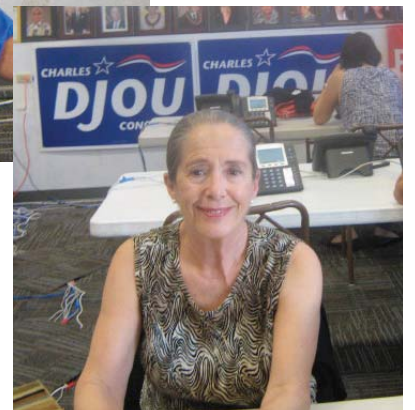

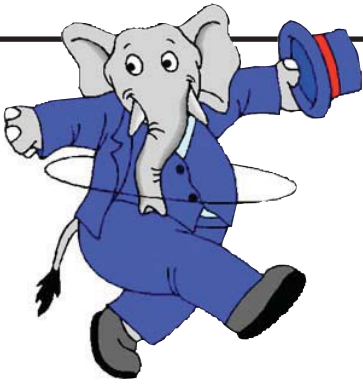
## Oahu League supports Charles Djou on election day

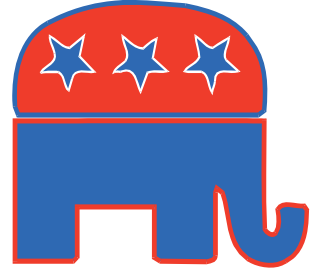
