When I spilled tea that weary day.

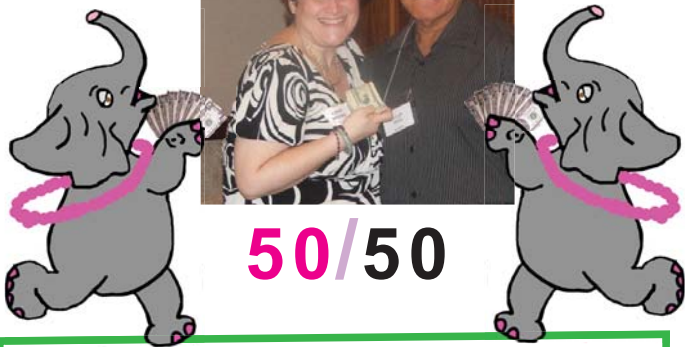
Blessed are they who, with cheery smile
