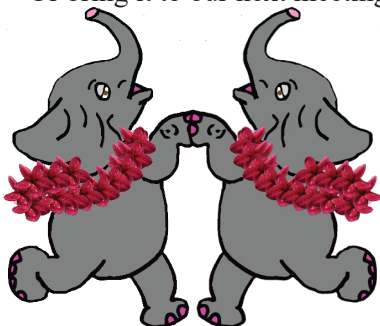
So, yeah, we may not win 10 seats this year, but we are far from the dismal mess that has been portrayed by the paper.
